Minutes

The minutes of a meeting of the Kirk Session held on Tuesday 20th April were approved with the following additions.

Arthur McDonald advised that the HIV Programme Co-Coordinator, Elena Sarra was concerned at the lack of response from Stirling Presbytery with regard to Souper Sunday.

Thirty one Presbyteries have responded to the challenge of Let Us Build a House with twenty nine already raising more that the £500 requested.

This year marks the 175th Anniversary of the Scottish Mission in Budapest – 16th-22nd September 2016.

The Strategy Committee will meet next in June.

Huge Buchanan advised that there were no changes to the roll since the last meeting.

CYF Worker

Sally Forshaw advised that Bible Alive Scripture Union group in the Allan's Primary has been completed and that the school are keen for us to deliver the programme as part of the Curriculum every year for P4/5.

Sally and Jane Harris will be meeting with the Chinese families to do a session on an introduction to Christianity.

Minister's Report

The Minister advised that the highlight of the month was his trip to Bethlehem and he gained further insight into the Middle East situation. He is thinking about ways that we can follow up as a Church.

The Boy's Brigade display night was well attended. Angela, Megan and Philip have stepped down from their duties and they are looking for new leaders. It was agreed that we should acknowledge the work and the time that they have give to the Boy's Brigade. Maybe flowers or a gift token with a card could be purchased.

Amy is employed to lead the Wellbeing Choir until the end of June costing £75 per evening. It is proposed that the Choir should continue up to Christmas due to the huge success.

Julie Christie has been employed for 12 hours per week to run the Lunch Club and to do some outreach work with the elderly in the area.

It is proposed to employ Karen McSorely for 6 hours per week to run a Creative Arts type of group.

This Sunday is Communion with the Wellbeing Choir singing and a bring and share lunch. The week after Lucy one of the Bairns' Rock children will be baptised. The Minister is officiating at a wedding in the Holy Rude Church on 20th August. It is proposed that we would host a Faith Missions training and outreach event jointly with YWAM at the end of August.

AOB

The Minister advised that the website has not been in a functioning condition since February and that no-one has been able to log on.

Ed, Kristen and Bill asked to negotiate with Karl for a solution to this problem. The Minister asked us to consider how we can support the Boy's Brigade leadership problem and advised that Ian McCallum was prepared to be Captain short term. We have had a letter from the Gideon organisation thanking us for hosting their annual lunch.

The Minister advised that he is waiting for a confirmation of a date that the Strategy Committee will meet with us. This would take place in June.
